January 24, 2021 Third Sunday of Ordinary Time A message from Fr. Rob...

As Jesus began His ministry, He invited ordinary people from all walks of life to listen to His words and to follow Him. It was a simple invitation with profound significance. He was inviting them to a complete change of life. Jesus, the Word Made Flesh, speaks and the Word spoken has an immediate effect. Those first disciples left everything to follow the Lord. The prophet Jonah, having heard God's command (though it took a time or two to get the message to sink in) went to Nineveh and began to proclaim God's message. It had an immediate effect. The people of Nineveh repented and changed their ways upon hearing the words of Jonah.

Today we celebrate the **Sunday of the Word of God**, another result of the Year of Mercy. Pope Francis intends this Sunday (3rd Sunday of Ordinary Time) to be an opportunity for us to reflect on the power of God's Word and the life it brings when we embrace it completely. Set at the start of the Ordinary Time Season, it lays out the foundation of a year long focus on listening to and reflecting on the Word of God.




Your Loving Care,

Pope Francis on the Word of God Sunday...

of God) Regular reading of sacred Scripture and the celebration of the Eucharist make it possible for us to see ourselves as part of one another. As Christians, we are a single people, making our pilgrim way through history, sustained by the Lord, present in our midst, who speaks to us and

nourishes us. A day devoted to the Bible should not be seen as a yearly event but rather a yearlong event, for we urgently need to grow in our knowledge and love of the Scriptures and of the risen Lord, who continues to speak his word and to break bread in the community of believers. For this reason, we need to develop a closer relationship with sacred Scripture; otherwise, our hearts will remain cold and our eyes shut, struck as we are by so many forms of blindness. Sacred Scripture and sacraments are thus the inseparable. When the sacraments are introduced and illumined by God's word, they become ever more clearly the goal of a process whereby Christ opens our minds and hearts to acknowledge his saving work. We should always keep in mind the teaching found in the Book of Revelation: the Lord is standing at the door and knocking. If anyone should hear his voice and open for him, he will come in and eat with them (cf. 3:20). Christ Jesus is knocking at our door in the words of sacred Scripture. If we hear his voice and open the doors of our minds and hearts, then he will enter our lives and remain ever with us.
