### Sunday, January 28, 2024 Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time A Message from Fr. Rob

As we listen to the Gospel this weekend, we should notice how quickly Jesus set about fulfilling His mission. Having called the disciples to follow Him, now they are present in the synagogue (the place of prayer and worship) where they witness Jesus heal the man with the unclean spirit. Jesus came to bring healing: in body, mind and in spirit.

Each Sunday as we gather in church, we bring before the Lord our own personal need for healing as well as carrying in our hearts our loved ones, our friends and our world who also call out for healing. Sometimes healing is physical as in the recovery from sickness but other times it takes the form of a spiritual healing that brings comfort, peace, acceptance and strength.

Our prayers of intercession are powerful for those who carry heavy burdens. Humbling ourselves before God, we earnestly seek mercy and compassion for the sick and the suffering. We all carry heavy burdens and faces many challenges each day. We learned at an early age: don't judge another—we have no idea the trauma, challenges, burdens they carry in their hearts. We are called to be merciful and compassionate. Let us pray for our world in need of healing and peace.

Next weekend is our annual Parish Mission appeal. We support partners in two of Canada's far northern dioceses as well as Catholic Missions in Canada which offers to support to all of Canada's mission dioceses. We also support projects in Haiti and India thanks to your generosity. Envelopes are in the offertory boxes and can also be found at the doors of the churches.
