## January 31, 2021 Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time A Message from Fr. Rob....

One of the scenes played over and over again in the Gospels is that of Jesus bringing healing to situations of stress, sickness and worry. In all of those moments, Jesus speaks a word of peace. He commands with a voice of authority. He brings confidence and comfort to those who are suffering. In today's Gospel He relieves a man possessed of a demon in order to bring peace. Jesus wants to free all of us from what burdens us each day. These burdens weigh heavily upon us and cry out for relief. Only in the Lord can we find the true relief we are searching for each day.

One aspect of this pandemic has been a sense of fear, frustration, impatience, anger and lack of kindness. Fr. Daniel and I both have had moments where other professionals in the healthcare field, funerals homes, service industries etc. have turned to us in the moment to ask for prayers, for peace, for a word of comfort as they seek to serve. It is humbling for us and we do what we can to bring them God's peace in the midst of difficult circumstances.

Each day as we both pray together and celebrate mass, we look for ways to bring the Word of God to every situation we encounter. Twice this week we found solace in the words of the saints as we celebrated mass and took to heart their advice.

- 1. From St. John Vianney: "Do not try to please everybody. Try to please God, the angels, and the saints -they are your public."
- 2. From St. Angela Merici: "You will accomplish more by kind words and a courteous manner than by anger or sharp rebuke, which should never be used except in necessity."

Good advice for all of us to ponder.

Our three St. Vincent de Paul Societies respond to calls for food assistance every week. We thank the members for their outreach to those in need and to our parishioners for their financial and food donations.

Parishioners continue to pray daily for one another, especially for those who are sick at home and in hospital. We mourn with families who have lost loved ones and journey with them through funeral celebrations that are different yet so important to help bring healing and peace.

We continue to face many financial challenges due to the fact that we are not celebrating on the weekends. We appreciate the financial support that has been given that allows us to keep operating. We have benefitted from the government wage subsidy programme that has enabled us to keep working (even though we are in lockdown, there is still a ton of work being done to keep us operating).

As prudent stewards, we continue to engage in a comprehensive review of all expenditures and are eliminating, cutting back and making changes wherever we can in order to live with a reduced operating budget. We have no choice in this regard if we are to weather the financial challenges that we are experiencing along with so many other businesses in our communities.

We look forward to being able to gather in worship again soon. Please pray for one another.
