Sunday, June 12, 2022 – Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity A message from Fr. Rob....

While we have resumed the Season of Ordinary Time, these two Sundays present us with celebrations of our faith: the Trinity and next week, the Body and Blood of Jesus. Today we recognize that the Trinity is all about a relationship of love and how through baptism, we are all invited into that experience of love. Through the gift of the Holy Spirit, we encounter God's unconditional love for us. Jesus came to show us the Father. In Him, we encounter our Loving Father who cares for each one of us.

This week we will celebrate 3 year-end masses for our schools and two more next week. - wearing of masks in indoor settings is still encouraged; sensitivity to one another is essential.

- dispensation from the Sunday mass obligation has been extended until 6 September as there are still some people uncertain of attending mass
- sign of peace should be extended in a manner that makes people comfortable without necessitating actual contact with those not in our own household i.e. nod of head or gesture of peace
- communion ministers will continue to wear masks in the distribution of communion.
- those wishing to receive communion on the tongue must come last in line; minister must sanitize hands after each of these communicants
- offertory collection will return to within the mass
