Sunday, June 15, 2025 Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity



On this special Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity we are invited to think

about our relationship with God. Because we are created as spiritual beings, there is a longing in us to know more about the world and the beauty of life. All through the Old Testament, we find people longing to know God who is the Creator of all that exists. Through prayer and moments of encounter, they met a very personal God who revealed to them the gift of love. This love was solidified in the gift of Jesus, the Son of the Father.
