Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time Sunday 20 June 2021 A Message From Fr. Rob....

Fr. Daniel said to me this past Wednesday "This is your weekend." What did he mean by that? For the last year and a half as we have tried to weather the storm of the pandemic and meet the needs of the sick, the fearful, the angry, the bereaved and the uncertain, our mantra to each other, to the staff and to those we were assisting has been a simple "Calmez Vous – Be Calm" It is a recognition that in the midst of any confusion and doubt, it is the Lord who is with us to be our strength. Today's Gospel is a perfect example. In the midst of the storm, while the disciples are scared and panicking, Jesus simply says be at peace, be calm.

It has become our "go to" motto and has served us well in these last 16 months. We even use it with our brother priests. With God on our side, who can be against us? No one or nothing can keep us from experiencing the calming presence of the Lord. It calls for absolute trust. Job learns that lesson in the first reading as he speaks with God in the midst of the storm. God simply says be calm, know that I am with you. Is it not I who created the universe and all that it contains? Is that not the meaning of the Incarnation? Emmanuel, God is with us.

Let us continue to trust in the Lord and not allow the waves and wind to shake our foundations of faith. The Lord will be with us.
