Sunday, June 22, 2025 Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ



This weekend gives us a chance to intentionally focus on the importance of the Eucharist in our lives. This solemnity was instituted to reinforce in Catholic Christians a love for the Eucharist and a deep reverence for the Lord, present in the bread and wine which through the power of the Holy Spirit becomes the Body and Blood of Christ. It had become routine and commonplace with people having little regard for its importance or even believing the Lord is present in a very special way.

Once a year we get this reminder to create within us a love for this gift which we so desperately need. Firstly so that we are given the spiritual nourishment we require to live missionary lives as witnesses of Christ. Secondly, to keep alive a sense of reverence and awe each time we celebrate. The liturgy is not meant to be a show or a concert or a "feel good moment" but rather an act of worship of our God, revealed as Father, Son and Holy Spirit and who through this gift fills us with grace.

This Friday is the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We are reminded that the heart of Jesus has room for all. His love is unconditional and eternal. Flowing from His heart is mercy and peace. It is also set aside as a day of prayer for priests so that they might grow in holiness as they serve God's people. Holy Priests help to form Holy People. We rely on your prayers.
