March 13, 2022 Second Sunday of Lent A Message from Fr. Rob...

Today's Gospel provides a moment of awe for the disciples. They are eyewitnesses to a profound moment of grace. They see Jesus transfigured before them and they hear the Father's voice. They are amazed. Think of a time in your life when you were in awe. What was it? Seeing your grandchild for the first time? Witnessing a moment of beauty in nature? Being the recipient of a random act of kindness? How did you feel? What was your reaction?

God invites Abram to look up at the stars and to be in awe and to be amazed at the wonder of God's creation and to be even more in awe of God's promises. God wants to do the same for us. Despite the challenges and difficulties of life, there are plenty of awe moments. We just need to be attuned to them. Prayer helps us with that. By quieting ourselves, even in the face of many distractions, we can become more aware of the power of God's grace at work all around us.

Lent is meant to be a season of God moments, where we can experience the gift of grace and never fail to lose our sense of wonder. After all, it is one of the gifts of the Holy Spirit!

We continue to make progress with our re-opening procedures. It was great to be able to welcome people back last weekend without worrying about names on a list or making sure everyone was where they were supposed to be. We continue to adjust to the changing realities and continue to rely on your patience and understanding. We all need to be flexible. One thing that was very noticeable during the restrictions stage was everyone's willingness to go with the flow. Often people would call looking for a particular mass and if it was full, they opted to attend a different mass and even in a different church. Talk about working together as a family! That was indeed the Holy Spirit at work.


