In the event of the Transfiguration the disciples are privileged to witness the Light of God's Grace. Jesus shared this intimate moment of communion with His Father with them. He wanted them to experience and understand the closeness God desires with all God's children.

The Light of Christ shines in our world even when the circumstances of daily life or the darkness of world events make it hard to see. This is where determined faith plays a role. In the midst of challenges our spiritual life serves as a foundation to weather the uncertainty of life and to grow in trust.

Abram is invited by God to look up to the night sky and gaze upon the stars. Unable to count them, Abram is assured of God's loving providence and God's plan to bless Abram and his descendants. God invites us to do the same and see how plentiful are our blessings and the nearness of God's grace. The psalmist reminds us: "the Lord is my light and my salvation."

Peru is facing an ecological debt crisis as extractive industries, often foreignowned, plunder its natural resources, harming the environment and human rights.

These industries contribute to the unjust enrichment of the Global North

at the expense of the Global South. Thus, as countries in the Global South incur financial debts that further impoverish them, they are owed a mounting ecological debt by the Global North that is never settled.

Our partners, the Episcopal Commission for Social Action (CEAS) and the Institute Bartolomé de Las Casas (IBC) work closely with affected communities, advocating for justice and sustainable alternatives.

LITURGY UPDATE: As mentioned a few weeks ago, Bishop Fabbro has asked all parishes to ensure we are celebrating the liturgy according to Diocesan norms. Some parishes including some around us are a little behind in their revisions. We are in good shape except for the lingering confusion with regards to posture before communion. We kneel as the celebrant lifts up the Body and Blood and says "Behold the Lamb of God...." We respond "Lord I am not worthy to receive you..." Then everyone (if able) stands and prepares for the communion procession. The celebrant waits until all have stood and then begins the communion procession by receiving the Eucharist himself.


