Sunday, March 23, 2025 Third Sunday of Lent From Fr. Rob.....



As the good weather approaches, many of us are getting antsy and wanting to get outside and dig around. Spring is always a sign of new life and new growth. Lent is also a time of new life and new spiritual growth. How are we doing? Are we finding areas of our life that require some pruning? Are we watering the roots with the right stuff? Are we allowing God's Word to be the fertilizer we require to stimulate new growth?

As we begin this third week of Lent we can stop and take a moment to chart our progress. Do we need to re-double our efforts? Change our tactics? Perhaps throw it all out and start over? All good-whatever works to bring about the growth the Lord desires in us. Conversion takes time and effort.

Lent is a perfect time to sit before the Cross and ask the Lord for what will bring us the best growth. In a fast paced world with so much distraction and noise, we need to hold on to the Cross with both hands. 
