## Sunday, March 30, 2025 Fourth Sunday of Lent From Fr. Rob....



On this 4th Sunday of our Lenten journey, we hear the words of St. Paul: "So we are ambassadors for Christ, since God is making his appeal through us; we entreat you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God." This Sunday is known as Laetare Sunday, similar to Gaudete Sunday in Advent. It is a Sunday of joy. We wear our rose vestments again as a sign of the impending joy of the Resurrection.

Our Gospel speaks of the joy that comes with being loved and forgiven. The parable of the Prodigal Son is meant to get us to focus on our need to repent and to ask for forgiveness but only in the context of prayerfully accepting the unconditional love and mercy of God. The Father in the parable goes above and beyond to wipe away the shame of the son.

In the Sacrament of Reconciliation we are able to come before our Loving Father, laying before him our sins and failings but only that we might in a new and deeper way know we are loved and forgiven. Take advantage of this sacrament this Lent and have hope and joy restored.
