# Sunday, May 1, 2022 The Third Sunday of Easter

Our Easter readings continue to inspire us with moments of faith and openness to the Holy Spirit. The early Christian community responded to the needs of those around them. The Holy Spirit also empowered them to be bold witnesses of the Risen Lord. It is inspiring to see Peter and the other disciples stand up in front of the authorities and proclaim their faith in Jesus.

Following their example let us embrace the call to be bold witnesses, ready to stand up for what we believe. In the Gospel Jesus appears to the disciples again and affirms them in their new task to care for the flock that He is entrusting to them. He simply says to Peter, "care for my lambs, look after my sheep."

We all know what it means to care for one another: our families, co-workers, neighbours, classmates. We belong to the human family and we are to show to one another the care and compassion we daily receive from God. Next weekend is the 4th Sunday of Easter, known as Good Shepherd Sunday. Let us pray that our children and youth will be attentive to the voice of the Shepherd and heed His call and discern their proper vocation.


