The gift of the Risen Lord is peace.

Notice how many times in our Easter

Gospels that Jesus offers peace to the Apostles. He tells them to not be afraid and to dwell in His peace. To be aware of this peace is to be fully in tune with the Holy Spirit. That's why Jesus tells the disciples to prepare for the coming of the Spirit. The Spirit will always guide us in the ways of peace.

Our world is troubled with war, conflict, greed, misunderstandings, selfishness. Into this mess we are sent as messengers of peace. As we prepare for Pentecost let us earnestly pray for the gift of peace.

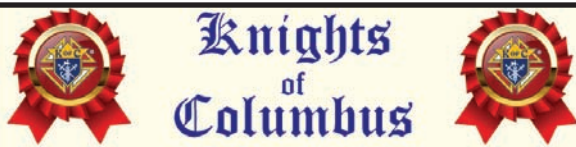
