The Most Holy Trinity Sunday 30 May 2021 A Message From Fr. Rob...

As priests, we are asked a lot of questions and not always just from children. Each of us, created as a spiritual being longs for deeper meaning and



an understanding of just how exactly the world works and why. A familiar question is "Who made God?" Try answering that to a class of Grade 2 children!

Jesus came to show us the Father and to help us realize that God is the beginning and the end. Our deepest longing begins with God and ends with God. God is the source of our life and the end toward which our life is directed. Jesus said to the crowds that He came to show us the Father. God desires to be in a relationship with us. It is a personal, intimate relationship. We are known and loved.

Today's celebration of the Most Holy Trinity is a revelation of who God is: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. In baptism we are introduced to a life of faith and a relationship of love. This life must be nourished by times of prayer, silent reflection and openness to doing what God desires. But God does not force us. Rather, God's desire is that we live a life of love, goodness, kindness, peacefulness and that can only happen if we are willing to keep searching and asking the tough questions.

RE-OPENING UPDATE

As you are aware, the Province of Ontario released an updated re-opening schedule last week. It has three phases and is very specific in terms of what opens and when etc. following scientific/medical criteria for % of vaccines administered etc. (see: news.ontario.ca roadmap to reopen)

We continue to perform funerals and baptisms with a 10 person limit. Bishop Fabbro will keep all weekday and weekend masses celebrated privately by the priests until we are able to fully re-open with a higher percentage of capacity. Confessions are available by calling the office to make an appointment.

As things go, we are not sure at this point of the re-opening date. We are in the phase 2 section of the protocols and it will depend on the success of the phase 1 criteria determined by the province.

I know this is frustrating and challenging for everyone. We continue to pray for an end to the pandemic and for healing. We pray for the young couples preparing for marriage, many of whom have had to re-schedule their weddings multiple times. We were ready to celebrate with our children and youth the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist and Confirmation and that has been put on hold. We are working on alternative dates yet again. We no longer put things in pen!

We know many of our elderly in nursing homes and assisted living facilities long for the presence of family members. We pray for a fast rollout of the 2nd shot for as many people as possible so we can achieve the % required and get back together worshipping.

If we hit the metrics required, we will open again to indoor religious gatherings at 15% capacity to begin with but we will have to wait and see. Let us continue to pray for one another.

We have had to re-think our plans yet again due to the current provincial re-opening schedule.




Families will be notified by Rachelle and Maria when a new plan is realized. These delays have given us lots of time to get through all the take home materials.


