Sunday, May 7, 2023 Fifth Sunday of Easter A Message from Fr. Rob

In our first reading today, we see how the needs of the community increased as more believers joined the Apostles in following Jesus. In response to the promptings of the Holy Spirit, the Apostles recognized the need to encourage the new believers to participate fully in the life of the community. They discerned how the Spirit had been poured out upon the community and began using the gifts of the members for the benefit of the whole community.

As in those days, the same is true of our times. The Holy Spirit is poured out upon all of us and each one of us possesses the gifts necessary to build up our faith families. We all have a part to play in finding our place and using our gifts wisely and generously in the service of others. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you in finding how you will build up our community.

As we continue the Easter Season, Jesus reminds us again of the goal: eternal life. In today's Gospel Jesus speaks directly to the disciples (and to us) of the place He is preparing in the Father's house. Let us keep our eyes on our eternal home and ask the Lord to guide our earthly steps so that we may continue to grow in holiness.
