AED (Defibrillator) TRAINING

We are in process of acquiring new machines as our old ones have expired. EMS will provide us with the training. Their goal is to get as many people in the community as possible trained and comfortable with the use of these machines in case of the event of an emergency.

We will offer training on **Wednesday, December 10th in the Atonement Family Centre, 6 pm-9 pm**. The plan is to have volunteers trained so that realistically we would have our five weekend masses covered. Training is free. We have room to train 16 for the first class. You must be willing to jump into action should need arise and be physically able to perform the task.
