Sunday, November 20, 2022 Solemnity of Christ the King

A message from Fr. Rob....

As we close the liturgical year with this solemnity today, we are offered a chance to truly embrace the kind of Kingdom that has God at the centre. The mission of Jesus was not to establish a type of human kingdom that would rival the Roman Empire or any of the other kingdoms that from time to time conquered Israel and took away their freedom.
