Sunday, November 27, 2022 First Sunday of Advent A message from Fr. Rob....

Advent is the start of a new liturgical year which really means a new beginning. We have an opportunity to start fresh and find new ways of being attentive to the Gospel and



listening to how the Lord is inviting us to embrace a life of intentional discipleship. The Gospel challenges us to be awake and aware. In this season as we pray for the Lord to return, we wait in hopeful expectation.

Waiting can sometimes be a frustrating experience but it can also be a fruitful experience. Sometimes we fill our waiting moments with worry, anxiety, frustration or even anger. Imagine the benefit to ourselves (and others) if we instead fill these moments with prayer and silence. Try it this week when you encounter a waiting moment —even at a red light. Breathe deeply and say Come Holy Spirit.

We are happy to have Bishop Fabbro with us this weekend. The closure of St. Vincent Parish is difficult for our Family of Parishes and we have much to be thankful for as they have responded to the Gospel in so many ways. But Advent is also a season of hope and we must look forward to strengthening one another in faith.

THE SEASON OF ADVENT

Today begins this special season. We must use this time wisely which is given over to reflection on the return of

Christ in glory first, and then on the Incarnation. As disciples, let us make every effort not to drag the Christmas Season too far ahead like our society does but instead focus on waiting, silence, patience. Come Lord Jesus.

LITURGICAL YEAR A-The Year of St. Matthew

St. Matthew's Gospel, which we will listen to starting this weekend stresses that Jesus is the Son of God who fulfills the Old Testament prophecy of a Messiah. Jesus is presented as a powerful prophet who proclaims in word and deed the Kingdom of God. Matthew contains major discourses of Jesus in which the Lord lays out the foundation of the Kingdom (i.e the Beatitudes) and then the expectation that disciples will be actively involved in mission. As we listen to the Gospel this year, let us be re-energized to a deeper commitment to following the Lord and finding ways to share the news of the Kingdom of God. Evangelization is the responsibility of each one of us. Pick up the phone or personally invite someone to come to mass with you and share in the journey of faith.
