Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran
Basilica



Today's feast of the dedication of a church in Rome may seem strange but it has important meaning. The Basilica of St. John Lateran is the Cathedral church of the Diocese of Rome. Pope Leo is the Bishop of Rome, following in the line of popes before him right to St. Peter. There is an inscription over the door which says mother and head of all the churches. It is meant to remind us of our unity through the ministry of the Holy Father as our Shepherd, Vicar of Christ, Pope and Bishop of Rome.

Unity is so essential to us as believers. When we profess the creed, we profess our unity of belief and practice. Belonging to the Catholic church means we recognize the universality of the church's mission and our oneness in Christ Jesus.

I will be in Rome on Tuesday, November 11th. My plan is to go through the Holy Door at St. Peter's, St. Mary Major and pray at the tomb of Pope Francis, and the door at St. John Lateran if time permits. In this jubilee year this will be a special grace and know that I will bring all of your prayerful intentions with me as I pass through the doors.

Again I offer my sincerest thanks to all of you for the birthday prayers, cards, gifts and hugs. One of my most memorable birthday celebrations I can recall. Your kindness is deeply treasured.

External debt and ecological debt: Who owes whom?

In Peru, extractive industries account for over 60 per cent of the country's exports. But this does little for Peruvians, 30 per cent of whom remain below the national poverty line. Mining has serious consequences for the environment and human rights. This adds to the ecological debt that rich countries, which benefit from this exploitation, owe to the local populations who suffer its harmful effects.

Our partners, the Episcopal Commission for Social Action (CEAS) and the Bartolomé de Las Casas Institute (IBC), work closely with affected communities to help them assert their rights. To find out more, watch this video: devp.org/videoPeru.


