Sunday, October 12, 2025 Twenty-eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

As we listen to the Word of God this weekend, we are reminded of the need to possess an attitude of gratitude. Funny how these stories fall on Thanksgiving Weekend when in our culture we all take a moment to express our thanks. It is a good reminder that gratitude is at the heart of our relationship with God. We are disciples of Jesus precisely because of the gift of faith that has been given to us at baptism. Living out that discipleship means making the honest effort to be more aware of our blessings and the movement of grace in our lives.

Sometimes our lives get in the way. Look at Naaman in the first reading. No way was he going to let some foreigner tell him what to do. He was prepared to live with his leprosy rather than do what was asked of him by the prophet Elisha nor admit that he was wrong. His lack of gratitude in this moment almost prevented him from receiving the healing he was looking for in the first place. When he finally gave in, gratitude replaced his resistance.

Thankfulness is so essential to our spiritual life. When we don't take time to review our blessings and the input of the Holy Spirit in our lives, we can become resentful and bitter, thinking God does not even notice us. How untrue this is. God's grace is always with us. We just need to take the time to reflect on it.


