A challenging aspect of our discipleship is figuring out prayer. We know it is not easy. First we deal with distractions, then time constraints, then we wonder what we are supposed to say or do etc. The readings this weekend offer us encouragement to persevere. That's half the battle right there. Prayer is not meant to be stressful or even work though at times it may seem like it is work. Rather, it is a commitment to spend time in the loving gaze of God, opening our heart and allowing ourself just to "be" with the Lord. Pastoral Update for St. Vincent de Paul Parish

The decrees of suppression of St. Vincent de Paul Parish and the closure of the building from Bishop Fabbro were posted last weekend. Now begins the time of transition. Firstly, we pray for all who are affected by this change. May the Lord continue to strengthen them in this time of loss. We are still working out the details of the closing celebration with the Bishop's schedule. We will not be able to use the building out of safety concerns so we are anticipating a modified closure ceremony outside followed by a closing mass at Our Lady of the Atonement.

Some items have already been brought over to our two other churches (altar linens, hymnals, vestments) and the kitchen items have been donated to the Society of St. Vincent de Paul and the Culinary Program at Brennan High School for use by the students. Liturgical items that can be used in one of our churches will be brought over while plans are being formulated to work with the Diocese to see if other parishes are in need of some of the liturgical furnishings (i.e. altar candles other hymnals etc.) Some items were not salvageable because of the condition of the basement.

It is a work in progress as we strive to incorporate elements of the faith experience of the St. Vincent de Paul community with the rest of our Family of Parishes.
