**Twenty-ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time
From the desk of Fr. Rob.....**

On the day we are baptized, we begin our journey of faith. We believe, to paraphrase St. Paul, that we are citizens not just of the planet earth but more so, citizens of the Kingdom of God. 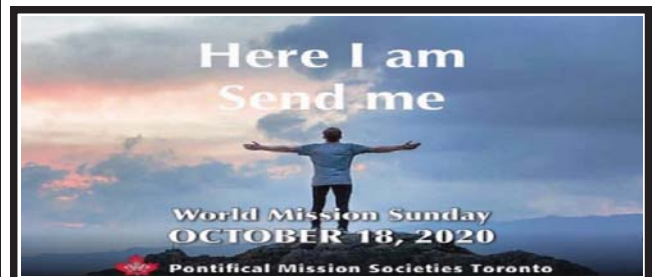
