WORLD MISSION SUNDAY

From Bishop Fabbro: On 20 October 2024, the 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time, we observe World Mission Sunday. This year's theme is "Go and invite everyone to the banquet" (cf. Mt. 22:9). For the last number of years, our parishes have carried on the work of being a mission-oriented Church. I took on as my vision statement, Diocese of London: Being a mission-oriented Church that forms disciples of Jesus. As we continue to move from maintenance to mission, we are starting to see the fruit of our efforts. There is, however, more to be done.

Pope Francis, in his message for World Mission Sunday, reminds us that the "Mission, is a tireless going out to all men and women, in order to invite them to encounter God and enter into communion with him." This "going out" is not simply a physical movement but it includes going out of our comfort zones, going out to meet those who have not yet received or embraced the Good News.

With "joy, magnanimity and benevolence" and with "closeness, compassion and tenderness", we are called to reflect God's own way of being and acting. By doing this, we witness to others the reason for our hope (cf. 1Pt. 3:15). We, the Church, each of us in our own way, are called to go out to the ends of the earth to bring the Good News to others by our witness of faith.

This universal collection, taken up in every parish around the world is an opportunity for all disciples to support the efforts of missionaries and mission churches supporting the faith life of the emerging church in mission areas around the world (including Northern Canada). Use the envelope provided in the offertory boxes or there are extras at the doors of the church. Let us pray for all missionaries that God may bless them.




