October 25, 2020 Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time From the desk of Fr. Rob......

We are quickly approaching the end of the liturgical year. Over the last few weeks we have been hearing parables about the Kingdom of God and how we are called to live in it as children of the light as well as prepare ourselves for eternal life with the Father. As part of that preparation, Jesus offers us the path to follow: simply love God and love your neighbour.

We learned this as children of course and it is reinforced each time we gather together to pray and worship the Lord. As disciples, we are called to love God: giving God our complete heart and holding nothing back because God does not withhold anything from us. And our love of God is shown in the manner by which we live our lives with love for others – with generosity, kindness, openness, compassion and respect.

The people of Israel were reminded that because they were God's chosen people, they had the responsibility to care for the widows, orphans and the poor. By doing so, they were showing their love of God and neighbour.

The next few weeks will be very challenging as we wrestle with colder weather, the need for continued vigilance and adherence to the COVID-19 protocols as well as trying to figure out pastoral planning for Advent and the Christmas Season, especially the schedule of masses.

ALL SOULS REMEMBRANCE

The month of November begins with two important solemnities: All Saints (Nov. 1) and All Souls (Nov 2). All Saints celebrates all those holy men and women, known and unknown, who now share around the throne of grace in the Kingdom and whom the Church acknowledges as saints. They pray for us and encourage us on our journey.

All Souls is a remembrance of all those who have gone before us and who await the fullness of the Resurrection to new life. This day reminds us that through the Risen Lord, we have the promise of eternal life with the Father. Jesus has conquered death.

During the month of November, we fondly remember in prayer all of our deceased loved ones who have gone before us. Because of the COVID-19 protocols, we will not be having the Book of the Names of the Dead this year as we cannot have people leaving their pews and coming forward to write in the names of the deceased.

Rest assured, during each celebration of the Eucharist during the month of November, we will remember in prayer *all of our deceased parishioners, loved ones and friends.*

Next weekend, the Solemnity of All Saints, we will begin each mass remembering in prayer all of the parishioners of our Family of Parishes who have died during this past year. This will replace for this year the annual memorial mass that we celebrate in normal times.

We will also celebrate mass on Monday, November 2nd, the Solemnity of All Souls. Mass will be at 9 am at St. John Vianney Church. In this mass we will also take a moment to remember all those who have died during this past year.
