In this wonderful encounter in the Gospel today, Jesus asks the blind man a simple question: 'What do

you want me to do for you?' Jesus has recognized the man's persistence and real need for an encounter of healing.

When we pray, Jesus asks us the same question. Our moments of silence are an opportunity to open our hearts to the healing presence of Jesus and to tell the Lord what we truly need.

The crowd sees the reaction of Jesus to this man in need and their attitude changes. Rather than telling him to be quiet and stay back, they see that Jesus wants to help the man and now they become sources of encouragement: "Take heart, get up, he is calling you." Let us be sources of encouragement for one another.

It was wonderful last weekend to be able to have the whole team present for masses and to take the opportunity to greet everyone. It is rare that we are able to do this and so this parking lot project gives us a chance to all be together and support each other as Family. After 5.5 years of travelling back and forth between multiple sites every weekend, the novelty of all being together over these weekends is a gift.
