Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

From the desk of Fr. Rob.....

Again St. Mathew's Gospel presents another teaching about the Kingdom of God. Using another parable, Jesus speaks of the Kingdom as a vineyard whose owner expects that the vineyard will produce. The owner entrusts his property to labourers who are expected to do the work. As we listen, we of course realize that Jesus means this parable for us. In baptism we have been entrusted with the work of the Kingdom of God. We are asked to work diligently to ensure that our lives are producing the fruits of the Kingdom of God.

As our world continues to slide deeper into conflict, rancour, war, disagreement and nastiness amongst one another, Christians are invited to bring love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, trustfulness, gentleness and self-control (see St. Paul's Letter to the Galatians 5:16-26 for an excellent prayer passage). In short, a Christian always shares the Light of Christ. *as of press time (Thurs. 11 am), our roof project at SJV is delayed so weekday mass will continue as usual this week unless announced otherwise on weekend.

This week I participated in a virtual meeting with our Bishops and all the pastors of the families of parishes-there are now 15 families up and running. We shared about the challenges of evangelization in light of the pandemic, the desire of our parishioners to remain connected to our communities and to our celebrations of the Eucharist and our concern for the sick, the lonely, the discouraged. All of us are feeling the effects these challenging days have had on us. We continue to pray for one another, asking the Lord for strength, joy and renewed zeal to share the Gospel. We are called to be missionary disciples - faithfully living the Gospel with trust and joy.
