Our Gospel this weekend presents Jesus' parables of the lost sheep, lost coin and lost son. As we listen, we are invited to think about the lengths God is prepared to go to ensure that no one gets lost. God is constantly looking out for us and bringing us back to His loving embrace with tenderness and compassion.

We face many challenges in trying to care for the sheep of our pasture. Each of us is a shepherd, tasked with loving and caring for the sheep around us. This task is at times thankless, frustrating, irritating, unending but it is also life-giving, fruitful, rewarding and inspiring.
