### September 20, 2020 Twenty-fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time From the desk of Fr. Rob......

Life is a journey. Sounds like a cliché doesn't it? But it is true. From the moment we are born and experience the gift of grace in baptism, we are on a journey of discovering the Lord each day. In today's first reading, the prophet Isaiah begins by simply saving: "Seek the Lord, while he may be found, call upon him while he is near:" It is an invitation to draw close to the Lord each day in prayer and in attentiveness to God's will. Especially in challenging times where we find ourselves lacking patience or becoming disagreeable or even worse, a life of prayer is a good antidote. Seeking the Lord each day and opening our hearts to the gifts of the Holy Spirit will help ward off even the darkest of clouds in our day.

Like the labourers in the parable; each of us is asked to go out into the vineyard and work for the Lord. We cannot and indeed must not answer for another or even concern ourselves with their progress or seeming lack of it besides being compassionate towards them and keeping them close in prayer as we pray they experience God's grace. God's mysterious grace is always at work in human hearts. Faith is trusting that God knows what God is doing; that should be enough for us if we truly believe. Like the parables heard over the last few weeks, we are meant to stand in wonder at just what a loving, merciful and generous God we have and allow the gift of grace to strengthen everyone.
