What's the point of discipleship? Of trying to live a good and upright life? Of following the commandments and seeking the Lord's guidance each day as we face the challenges of life? Some days it just seems so difficult and challenging when the world around us and so many of the people in it seem so lost and distracted by all the wrong things. Its tough to be a lone rubber beach ball floating far out to sea, surrounded by an immense ocean.

Sometimes it feels that way doesn't it? We watch tv, read the news and so much seems to be going so wrong. That is why St. Paul in our second reading outlines a Christian's responsibility: to pray for the world and those who lead it. "This is right and acceptable to God our Saviour, who desires everyone to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth." The world and many leaders like to play fast and easy with the truth. The modern world seems to think truth is subjective –you believe what you want to believe and I will do the same. Our salvation is in Jesus and the Truth He proclaimed.

Armed with the knowledge of our faith we can combat the nonsense that is so prevalent in the world today and build a firm foundation for ourselves and our children. Feel free to join us as we begin our Faith Formation this week looking in depth at the Nicene Creed, a pivotal document codified 1700 years ago as an antidote to the fake news and ridiculousness that was rampant, bringing about confusion and doubt.




