# September 22nd, 2024 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Last Sunday, Jesus issued the invitation to take up the cross and follow in His footsteps. Today he expands on the spirit of discipleship by reminding us "Whoever wants to be first must be last of all and servant of all." The challenge of our times (indeed every time) is to embrace the call of missionary discipleship. That means welcoming the Gospel in our hearts and allowing it to form us and then living by it so as to become an example of right living. If we are salt for the earth and light for the world in our words and actions, people's lives will be touched. We have 2000 years of the example of the martyrs and saints to inspire us.

This Thursday we honour St. John Brebeuf, St. Isaac Jogues and their companions, six priests and 2 lay men who were martyred between 1642 and 1649. They are the secondary patrons of Canada. These 8 men boldly proclaimed the Gospel in challenging circumstances and faced a martyr's death. Their desire was for the Gospel of Jesus Christ to be proclaimed and embraced, even in the face of great adversity. Their example of prayer, holiness and steadfastness are an inspiration for us.

PARKING LOT PROJECTS

Tenders were sent out this past week and are expected back on Tuesday. The contract will be awarded shortly thereafter.

Both sites will require a minimum of 2 weeks for the task. (Pray for good weather). We will begin with St. John Vianney. Once the contract has been signed, a timeline will be developed.

During the reconstruction, each church site will be inaccessible. The parish team is working on a mass plan which will be finalized as soon as the contract is awarded and the contractor sets a start date. Each church will be closed for 2 successive weekends (and weekdays). All weekday and weekend masses will occur at OLA while the lot is worked on at SJV, and then the same will occur with masses at SJV while the lot is worked on at OLA. We are blessed to have two churches that will accommodate everyone. It will be a great way to show our Family of Parishes working together and providing hospitality to one another during the construction period.

There is not enough street or local parking to accommodate the celebration of mass during the construction period. It will require patience and flexibility from everyone but at the end of the day will be well worth the inconvenience. Make plans now to car pool and offer assistance to those in need of a ride. STAY TUNED as we must be very flexible.
