September 27, 2020 Twenty-sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time From the desk of Fr. Rob......

St. Paul in his beautiful Letter to the Philippians offers us today plenty of food for thought. He asks us to remember the example of Jesus, who though God humbled himself and took on our humanity in order to show us the way to the Father. Consequently Paul encourages us in this way: "Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus." It is an invitation for us to be about the process of conversion and to allow God's mercy and grace to transform our hearts.

Conversion is on-going in the Christian life. We make progress, we stumble and fall, we get back up again. Paul having experienced God's mercy reminds us that this gift is available to all of us.
