# September 8th, 2024 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

A number of years ago, a book was written about Mother Teresa entitled "Surprised by joy." In her vocational choice, she had many opportunities to discern God's will and figure out what was being asked of her. When the moment of her conversion arrived and as she felt the call to serve the poorest of the poor, she ended up discovering the joy of serving according to the Lord's plan and this joy, despite challenges and difficulties, sustained her.

Our readings invite us to be surprised by joy by opening our eyes and hearts to the wonder of God's grace working all around us. Too often we may find ourselves closeminded: to new things, to new people and new experiences. Jesus commands "Be opened..." 


