

BAPTISMS

Parents themselves should pick up and return a completed Baptism Information Form to the parish office at least 4 months in advance of the anticipated baptismal date. An interview with a parish priest or deacon is required. Parents of children to be baptized should be registered members of our Parish Community. Attendance at a Baptism Preparation Meeting is mandatory.

CARE of the SICK: Visitation and/or Communion for the sick upon request.

MARRIAGE

Couples themselves must contact the parish office at least **one full year in advance** of the anticipated marriage date. No date may be set before meeting with the priest. A Marriage Preparation Course is required. If either party has been previously married, permission to proceed must be obtained from the Chancery Office of the Archdiocese.

We hope that Marriage Sunday provides a special opportunity to celebrate the sacrament and give thanks for those who strengthen our communities throughout their loving commitment to god, their family and one another.

WHAT IS THE ATTITUDE OF THE CHURCH TOWARD THE SICK?

Having received from the Lord the charge to heal the sick, the Church strives to carry it out by taking care of the sick and accompanying them with her prayer of intercession. Above all, the Church possesses a sacrament specifically intended for the benefit of the sick. This sacrament was intuited by Christ and is attested by Saint James: "Is anyone among you sick? Let him call in the presbyters of the Church and let them pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord" (James 5:14-15). (#315, Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church)

WHO CAN RECEIVE THE SACRAMENT OF THE ANNOINTING OF THE SICK?

Any member of the faithful can receive this sacrament as soon as he or she begins to be in danger of death because of sickness or old age. The faithful who receive this sacrament can receive it several times if their illness becomes worse or another serious illness afflicts them. The celebration of this sacrament should, if possible, be preceded by individual confession on the part of the sick person. (#316, Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church)

WHO CAN ADMINSTERS THIS SACRAMENT?

This sacrament can be administered only by priest (bishops or presbyters). (#317, Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church)

HOW IS THIS SACRAMENT CELEBRATED?

The celebration of this sacrament consists essentially in an anointing with oil which may be blessed by the bishop. The anointing is on the forehead and on the hands of the sick person (in the Roman rite) or also on other parts of the body (in other rites) accompanied by the prayer of the priest who asks for the special grace of this sacrament. (#317, Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church)


