FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI



The Feast of Corpus Christi (The Body and Blood of Christ) celebrates the gift of the Eucharist. As Catholics, we believe that the bread and wine placed on the altar are transformed by the words of the priest and the breath of the Spirit.

They become the true Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, our risen Lord and Saviour. To receive Holy Communion is to receive Jesus into our hearts.

"Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed."



EUCHARIST

Eucharist (Greek *eucharistia* = thanksgiving) was at first the name for the prayer of thanksgiving that preceded the transformation of the bread and wine into Christ's Body and Blood in the liturgy of the early Church. Later the term was applied to the whole celebration of the Mass.

In what way is Christ there when the Eucharist is celebrated?

Christ is mysteriously but really present in the Sacrament of the Eucharist. As often as the Church fulfills Jesus' command, "Do this in remembrance of me." (1 Cor 11:24), breaks the bread and offers the chalice, the same thing takes place today that happened then: Christ truly gives himself for us, and we truly gain a share in him. The unique and unrepeatable sacrifice of Christ on the Cross is made present on the altar; the work of our redemption is accomplished.


