Feast of Corpus Christi



The Feast of Corpus Christi (The Body and Blood of Christ) celebrates the gift of the Eucharist. As Catholics we believe that the bread and wine placed on the altar are transformed by the words of the priest and the breath of the Spirit. They become the true Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, our risen Lord and Saviour. To receive Holy Communion is to receive Jesus into our hearts.

"Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed."



JUNE MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART OF IESUS

Jesus know us and loved us with a human heart. His Heart, pierced for our salvation, is the symbol of that infinitive love with which he loves the Father and each one of us.

Friday, June 27th is the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. That's the highest rank of feast day.

Tuesday, June 24th is the *Nativity of Saint John the Baptist.*

Saturday, June 28th is the *Feast of St. Iranaeus*, bishop and martyr.

THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

The Eucharist is the very sacrifice of the Body and Blood of the Lord Jesus which he instituted to perpetuate the sacrifice of the cross throughout the ages until he returns in glory. Thus he entrusted to his Church this memorial of his death and Resurrection. It is a sign of unity, a bond of charity, a paschal banquet, in which Christ is consumed, the mind is filled with grace, and a pledge of future glory is given to us.

Jesus institute the Eucharist. After he had gathered with his apostles in the Cenacle, Jesus took bread in his hands. He broke it and gave it to them saying, "Take this and eat it, all of you; this is my Body which will be given up for you." Then, he took the cup of wine in his hands and said, "Take this and drink of this, all of you. This is the cup of my Blood, the Blood of the new and everlasting covenant. It will be shed for you and for all so that sins may be forgiven. Do this in memory of me."

The Eucharist is the source and summit of all Christian life. In the Eucharist, the sanctifying action of God in our regard and our worship of him reach their high point. It contains the whole spiritual good of the Church, Christ himself, our Pasch. Communion with divine life and the unity of the People of God are both expressed and effected by the Eucharist. Through the Eucharistic celebration we are united already with the liturgy of heaven and we have a foretaste of eternal life.

Jesus Christ is present in the Eucharist in a unique and incomparable way. He is present in a true, real and substantial way, with his Body and his Blood, with his Soul and his Divinity. In the Eucharistic, therefore, there is present in a sacramental way, that is, under the Eucharistic species of bread and wine, Christ whole and entire, God and Man.

Transubstantiation means the change of the whole substance of bread into the substance of the Body of Christ and of the whole substance of wine into the substance of his Blood. This change is brought about in the Eucharistic prayer through the efficacy of the word of Christ and by the action of the Holy Spirit. However, the outward characteristics of bread and wine, that is the "Eucharistic species", remain unaltered.


