BAPTISMS

"Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord."



Palm Sunday is the final Sunday of Lent, the beginning of Holy Week and commemorates the triumphant arrival of Christ in Jerusalem, days before he was crucified.

Palm Sunday is known as such because the faithful will often receive palm fronds which they use to participate in the reenactment of Christ's arrival in Jerusalem. In the Gospels, Jesus entered Jerusalem riding a young donkey, and to the lavish praise of the townspeople who threw clothes, or possibly palms or small branches, in front of him as a sign of homage. This was a customary practice for people of great respect.

Palm branches are widely recognized symbol of peace and victory, hence their preferred use on Palm Sunday. The use of donkey instead of a horse is highly symbolic, it represents the humble arrival of someone in peace, as opposed to arriving on a steed in war. A week later, Christ would rise from the dead on the first Easter.

During Palm Sunday, palms are distributed to parishioners. The palms are blessed and many people will fashion them into small crosses or other items of personal items. Because the palms are blessed, they may not be discarded as trash. The colours of the Mass on Palm Sunday are red and white, symbolizing the redemption in blood that Christ paid for the world.

PASCHAL FAST

Good Friday fast is considered as the "paschal fast" honouring the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus. Good Friday is the most sorrowful, the most somber, and also one of the holiest and vital days of the Christian year.

Reasons for Fasting on Good Friday:

- Obedience—The Catholics fast on good Friday out of obedience as they believe "Our Lord and His Apostles tell us to". Catholics also believe that Good Friday fasting aids them to get their body disciplined and get spiritually focused intently.
- Penance—They also fast to do penance. The observance of the holy law of fasting, by the Christian men includes to withdraw from sin, detest the past life badly lived, or confess the sins. Penance also means satisfying divine justice with prayer, fasting, almsgiving, and following the spiritual life. Fasting says that you are sorry for every wrongdoing, large or small. Accepting God's punishment means you are punishing yourself. The Church therefore, declares that all faithful followers fast and get the opportunity to reap worthy fruits of penance.
