WHAT HAPPENED AT PENTECOST?

Fifty days after the Resurrection at Pentecost the glorified Jesus Christ poured out the Spirit in abundance and revealed him as a divine Person so that the Holy Trinity was fully manifest. The mission of Christ and of the Spirit become the mission of the Church which is sent to proclaim and spread the mystery of the communion of the Holy Trinity. (#144, Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church)

WHAT IS THE WORK OF THE SPIRIT IN MARY?

The Holy Spirit brought to fulfillment in Mary all the waiting and the preparation of the Old Testament for the coming of Christ. In a singular way he filled her with grace and made her virginity fruitful so that she could give birth to the Son of God made flesh. He made her the Mother of the "whole Christ", that is, of Jesus the Head and of the Church his body. Mary was present with the twelve on the day of Pentecost when the Holy Spirit inaugurated the "last days" with the manifestation of the Church. (#142, Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church)

HUMANITARIAN RELIEF INDIA—COVID 19

India is reeling from a devastating COVID-19 outbreak. In recent days, the country has been reporting more than 400,000 of new cases and 4,000 deaths every 24 hours.

The Archdiocese of Toronto will send humanitarian donations to India through Development and Peace Internationalis. an international Caritas confederation of Catholic humanitarian organizations that is already in India helping those who are suffering during this COVID-19 outbreak. Since the pandemic began, India's Catholic Church, acting principally through Caritas India, has been supporting some of the most disadvantaged groups, such as those with inadequate housing, migrant labourers, persons with special needs and widows. Relief services and materials provided by the Church, or with its supports include:

- providing food at kitchens and distribution centers in slums and at migration transit points;
- providing masks, sanitizers and hygiene kits to vulnerable communities;
- providing psychosocial support and hotline services to traumatized and grieving persons;
- providing public education campaigns on infection prevention and vaccination;
- supporting the public healthcare system, including donating expertise, facilities and equipment from Church-run clinics and hospitals.
