In April 2010, Archbishop Collins announced that the Archdiocese would establish a group of lay experts to review current practices. The group has concluded their work and in September 2010, meetings were held with priests, deacons and lay staff of the Archdiocese to review the document.

CANONIZATION OF BROTHER ANDRÉ



In canonization Brother André on October 17th, His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI has recognized him as a model and example for the universal Church. It is an important day for the

Church of Montréal, which was built by, and continues to be inspired by, men and women full of zeal of faith.

The founder of Saint Joseph's Oratory is the second Canadian-born saint, after Saint Marguerite d'Youville. This event has great importance, not only for Catholics but for all Quebecers, all Canadians, and even people beyond our borders who have come to know and love Brother André throughout the world. Brother André is one of that rare class of founders and builders who know how to inspire us. His signature work, the Oratory, has become a major site of prayer and spirituality. His little chapel is now a basilica, the largest church of Montréal. Overlooking the city, it brings us closer to heaven.

The work of Brother André continues even today. The Oratory continues to receive large numbers of visitors. Many of these, of course, are Catholics, but there are also others of different religious traditions who recognize the sacred nature of the site. They come to this holy place to pray, to find themselves, and to breathe in its peace. In this regard, could Brother André not be considered a prophet for the spirituality of the 21st century?
