MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

BLESSED JUVENAL ANCINA

Blessed Juvenal is the only Oratorian

Blessed to have known St. Philip

personally. A physician, he was moved to

a deeper practice of his faith one day

when hearing the *Dies Irae* at a funeral.

He and his brother Giovanni Matteo went

to Rome seeking a vocation and thought

of joining the Carthusians. On a second

trip to Rome Juvenal discovered the

Oratory, and St. Philip persuaded him to

join, where he became one of the most

popular preachers, and also composed

music which was used at the Oratory exercises. In 1586 he

was sent to the new Oratory at Naples, where his fame as a

good preacher and holy priest continued to grow. When there

was talk that he would be made a bishop he went into hiding

for several months! But after St. Philip's death he was unable

to avoid the desires of the Holy Father and in 1602 was made

Bishop of Saluzzo in Piedmont. St. Francis de Sales was a close

friend and gave testimony at the Process for Juvenal's

beatification. In 1604 Juvenal was poisoned by a friar whom

he had rebuked for scandalous living. Fairly certain (as a

medical doctor) of what caused his sickness, Juvenal refused

to testify against the friar. He was beatified by Pope Leo XIII

on 9th February, 1890. *Join us for a Sung English Mass at*

Dear M.V.,

Please be assured that these women are Catholic Christians in good standing! I would encourage you, in the future, to go and speak to them directly. You will notice a crucifix on their religious habit. These women are one of the greatest blessings in our parish boundaries. They are *Missionaries of Charity, Sisters of St Teresa of Calcutta*. Their mission is to make the Church fully present here in Parkdale by serving freely the "poorest of the poor."

Please pray for them this week as they are preparing for the feast day of Mother Teresa. In fact, there will be a special **sung Mass at 10am in Holy Family on September 5**. In that Mass, as in every Mass, we are invited to receive what looks like bread and tastes like bread, but is truly the Body of Christ.

You spoke of the sisters taking the "bread. We speak of it as the Holy Eucharist, the Blessed Sacrament, Holy Communion. This Bread of Life is truly Jesus Himself.
