MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

PASTOR'S CORNER – Letter to the Bulletin Editor

Dear Priest Michael Eades, Oratorian father,
I am very surprised at the error in your last bulletin. You or the editor of the bulletin said that February 25, 2027 would be the 125th anniversary of Holy Family church. But are you not forgetting that February 25 is the dedication of the new Holy Family church? From what I can tell, the original Holy Family church was begun on June 22, 1902 when the corner stone was laid. The old church was dedicated on December 7, 1902. Our real 125th anniversary will be in June! Please respond to this letter. I am sorry for my handwriting. Sincerely, An elderly friend

PS: I hope you will have the guts to retract your mistake or at least publish my opinion on this matter.

Dear Concerned Friend,

I thank you for your note about last week's bulletin. By God's providence, we recently found many files related to the history of our parish. Yes, you are right! I admit my mistake. I retract. Our original anniversary date is not February 25, but later in the year. I pray that our parish will grow in her knowledge of her own history. I applaud your historical sense. A parish is the basic building block of a local Church. The parish is often the first way we meet the Lord and encounter His Church. I hope we can celebrate our 125th!

One of the great challenges of making real to oneself the history of Holy Family is precisely the point you make: the fire that destroyed our first church in 1997. We do not have the original structure that Fr Coyle built and Fr Brennan improved on (after World War II). Did you ever know our two founding priests? They served our parish for a combined 65 years.
