

Dear Friends!

Jesus is Risen! Alleluia!!! On behalf of Fr. Joi and our staff, I wish you all a very **Happy and Blessed Easter!** Today is the most joyful part of our faith. **He is Risen from the dead! Alleluia!**



Darkness into Light!!! Sorrow into Joy!!! At our Good Friday Liturgy, a Cross covered with a red cloth was processed up the aisle and unveiled in three stages! At each stage the priest sang, **"Behold, behold the wood of the Cross, on which is hung our Salvation!"** Then we venerated the Wood of the Cross! He died this death for me and you! Then, at the Easter Vigil a fire was lit, and blessed... and a new Paschal Candle was carried into a darkened church. And its light illuminated the dark as we lit a candle from our Source of Light! Ironically, in the same three places where the cross was unveiled, the priest now sang, **"Christ our Light!"** Our Lord and Saviour, who hung upon the Cross on that dark Good Friday... brings light into our lives... into our world! Darkness into Light! Sorrow into Joy!

And the joy today is that Jesus Christ is risen from the dead. Alleluia! And we have risen with Him. Risen to a new life, the life of baptism, the life of Jesus Christ! We are an Easter people, because we have received the resurrected life of Christ at our baptism. What does that mean? It means that we who possess the life of Christ, are called to make the Kingdom of God a reality! To continue his mission and ministry. Christ has called us out of darkness and death and given each one of us the ability to make his presence real for others. We pray today for the courage to bring his New Life to others.

Easter Sunday is a great day, especially in this **Year of Hope**, to re-commit ourselves to live this new life, spread this new life, and to allow Christ to use us to transform the world. And God knows there's much transforming that needs to be done. Look at the pain and devastation with ongoing war in many parts of the world. Even in Jesus' ancestral land. Look at the challenges to our economy, and the challenge with international relations. Look at the challenges to the sanctity of human life. Look around our own country and town at the poverty, the drugs, the crime. Maybe look at the imperfections or tensions in our own families and relationships.

My prayer is that we will find the strength in the Risen Christ this Easter to transform ourselves, so that we may bring his light and hope to any darkness we encounter! The tomb is empty. The Saviour Lives. May His Life change us, and send us out to change the world. Alleluia. Happy Easter!
