

Spring is slowly starting to spring. Before long, we will have blooming daffodils and tulips! Never lose hope! The snow last Sunday came as quite a surprise! It was a day too early for an April Fool!

Sadly, as we were gathering for Mass last Sunday, God called home Mr. Ken Walsh (Kenny). Kenny was the founder of Ryan's Bowl! He took up the Gospel call to feed the poor. And St. Patrick Parish has been one of his great supporters. So far this February and March, through donations in the parish, we have contributed \$10,000 to Ryan's Bowl. God bless our parishioners! On Wednesday evening, following the 7:00 PM Mass, Ms Isabella Bujor, the new Director for Ryan's Bowl, addressed our community. He wrote in the sand, *Let anyone among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her*. And the crowd went away one by one! Jesus was left alone with the woman. Imagine how she must have felt? There was no interrogation, no putting her down, no stare of disgust. Only gentle words: "Go your way, and from now on do not sin again." The relief she must have felt! No doubt, her life was changed forever. She was given a chance to start over again!

The good news is, no matter what we have done, there's someone to whom we can go, who knows everything about us and who loves us! **That one is Jesus!** He knows what we have done and failed to do. He doesn't say it's OK, because it's not. But he understands us... our condition, our circumstances; he understands that all have sinned and fallen short of God's way! And he is the only one who can give us back our self-respect, our dignity, our soul!!! That is the sacrament of Reconciliation. This is what Jesus celebrated with this woman!

As we near Easter, may we all take the sacred time to free ourselves at the feet of Jesus, free ourselves from our sin, our dirt, our shortcomings! Take advantage of God's healing love and grace! Then we can approach Easter with the same joy as the sinful woman! Have a blessed week!

This weekend a special collection will be taken in all Catholic churches in Canada for Development and Peace. This was established in 1967 by the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops in response to Pope Paul VI's encyclical letter, *Populorum Progressio*, which says that *Development* is the new word for *Peace*. Peace cannot be seen simply as the absence of war. It must be built daily, and it must strive towards a more perfect justice among human beings. Development and Peace seeks ways to help people of all faiths in the developing world to break the cycle of poverty through community-based, sustainable development initiatives. It supports partners working in order to improve living conditions in 70 countries in Africa, Asia ,Latin America and the Middle East. The programs involve issues relating to people's right to better education, women's equality, agrarian reform, housing and cooperative movements. The funds we send abroad support grassroots organizations run by people who know firsthand the issues facing the developing world. Envelopes are available at the doors of the church this weekend, and also in your offertory boxes. A second collection will be taken.

Ryan's Bowl Food Program "A Lenten Sacrifice" for St. Pat's!

IMPORTANT SYRIAN REFUGEE UPDATE

In 2016 our parish sponsored the **Krait Family** of 3 (Ayman, Souzie and Stephanie). In 2017 we sponsored the **Maalouf Family** of 4 (Bassem, Alma, Celena and Alexandr). Bassem's brother Antoun, and his wife and family were sponsored by St. Kevin's Parish; and Bassem's sister Mirna and her husband and family were sponsored privately in Grimsby. Our Parish made application over a year ago, through the Diocese, to sponsor the **Maalouf parents**, **Ghassan (72) and Amira (66)**. They fled Syria and stayed in Lebanon. It has not been an easy 4 years. At times when things worsened, they had to flee back to Syria. They wanted all their kids and grandkids to be safe and to get a second chance at life first. All of them are happily and safely settled here and doing well.



Praise God. We just received word that Ghassan and Amira will be having their second interview with the Canadian Embassy in Lebanon on April ,9th, which means (hopefully), that they will be coming to Canada soon. Back in 2016, we raised \$67,000 through the generosity of our parishioners. We have approximately \$5000 remaining in the Refugee Fund. Ghassan and Amira will stay in our Maple Street Refugee House with their son Bassem and family. We will need

approximately another \$10,000 to offset the cost of their first year. Their families will also assist. If any parishioners would like to assist, please make cheque payable to St. Patrick Parish and indicate (Refugee Fund) on the cheque. We are the only parish in the Diocese who have sponsored and fully funded more than one family! This will be our third! That bespeaks the generosity and big hearts of our people. Let's reunite mom and dad with their three children and 6 grandchildren!
