## Update on our Second Refugee Family.

We are still awaiting the arrival of our second refugee family. Nine (9) other parishes in the diocese are still waiting for their first family. I was at a meeting with the diocese last Thursday night. The process is very slow. I've exhausted every form of contact with the authorities... and basically, we have to wait! There's not enough staff at the Canadian Embassy in Lebanon to process the applications. The staff were sent home after the "quota" was met last February. It's sad and shocking that we have a place for them to stay, and there's been very little movement. I communicate every week with the dad, Bassem. His wife Alma, and children, Celena and Alexandr are having a difficult time in Lebanon. First, because they are Christian, and second, because they are Syrian. It's so sad. They are really in an ADVENT, as they wait in hope for good things to come. In his correspondence last week Bassem wrote, "Hi Dad, thanks for everything and we pray every day to go to Canada and tell my kids that there is a beautiful House, schools and friends waiting for you and we promise them always with beautiful days in Canada . See you soon. Thank you dad and thanks to everyone who helps us." Clearly the word "Father" doesn't translate well into English! Our first family, the Kraits, will be spreading their Canadian wings in February, as they become fully independent. Both mom and dad have jobs, Stephanie has settled in very well in school, they have saved enough money to buy a used car, so we will be hunting for a 2-bedroom apartment for them after Christmas! God bless our parishioners for making this ministry possible. To Team Members, we will have another Refugee Team Meeting as soon as we receive word about our Second Family!



Children are more than welcome, and absolutely and strongly encouraged to come and celebrate at St. Patrick's with their parents. We had an unfortunate episode recently whereby some unknown woman, scolded a young mother after the 9:30 Sunday Mass

about her children. The mother had 4 children with her. She was yelled at, and lectured in a rather demeaning fashion... *"If you're going to have that many children, you have to learn to control them first!"* The mother left our church in tears, with her 4 little children in tow! That's not what St. Pat's is all about. The children are our future. Please! We all need to be patient and tolerant. If a child is having a bad day, and is disrupting the entire congregation (which I have yet to see happen), parents can simply take the child to the foyer of the church, and have the ushers close the doors. A speaker has been installed in the foyer for that purpose. "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them!" God bless our young parents! And welcome to all our little children. My deepest apologies to the mother and children involved.
