The Third Sunday of Advent is here already! Today is *Gaudete* Sunday. *Gaudete* means *to rejoice*. Our readings are filled with so much joy and hope. "Rejoice" is also repeated throughout the readings and prayers. The vestments worn by the priest can be the colour rose. The third candle of the Advent wreath is also rose. Both are reminders that Christ's coming is very soon; we are nearing the end of Advent, and we can hardly contain our joy. *(Miller)*
