Dear Friends:

Our scripture readings for this 3rd Sunday of Advent are filled with joy! Zephaniah says, Sing aloud, O daughter, Zion! Our Psalm, Shout aloud and sing for joy! St. Paul, from prison writes, Rejoice in the Lord, again, I will say, Rejoice! And in the Gospel, the people whom John was baptizing, were filled with expectation! Today is *Gaudete* Sunday. *Gaudete* means *to rejoice*.



The Church calls for **joyful hearts** as we prepare to celebrate Christ's birth. May we make more room for Christ in our lives. If there are areas of our lives that are

not joyful, then we **need** to do something about it... allow Christ in! What are the things that "hinder me from welcoming Christ with joy?" This Wednesday we will have our Reconciliation service at 7:00 PM. Maybe we can be freed from whatever weighs us down!

Many people do not find this time of year to be joyful. Our call is to be there to help them, to give them reason **to rejoice**. We remember especially those who have lost a loved one this year. The first Christmas without a family member is very difficult and painful. We cannot take away another's grief, but **we can** be a comforting presence! We must be there to support those who are experiencing family and marital problems. We remember, and do what we can, to help those who are homeless and poor; those facing financial hardships. That's what John calls for in today's Gospel, *share with those who have none!*

We signed out some 300 tags! I can only imagine the joy our two refugee families must have felt after they were notified that they had a home in Niagara Falls! Especially having spent the past 16 months in a Lebanon Refugee Camp. Let's continue to put light where there's no light, hope where there's no hope, joy where there's no joy... and love where there's no love. Let's give others reason to rejoice! And may all of us rejoice in what God has done for us... and will do for us. Gaudete!
