

It's hard to believe that the Third Sunday of Advent is here already! Our readings for this Sunday are filled with so much joy and hope. Zephaniah says, Sing aloud, O daughter, Zion! Our Psalm, Shout aloud and sing for joy! St. Paul, from prison writes, Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I will say, Rejoice! "Rejoice" is also repeated throughout the readings and prayers. The vestments worn by the priest can be the colour rose (sometimes referred to as pink). The third candle of the Advent wreath is also rose. Both are reminders that Christ's coming is very soon; we are nearing the end of Advent, and we can hardly contain our joy. *(Miller)*
