

Our Diocese is hoping to rent some warehouse space so we can store extra furniture for other families who will be arriving. We have 14 parishes in the process of raising funds. God bless you for your generosity, in responding to this Gospel call! St. Pat's has always gone above and beyond! We are the first parish in our Diocese who have reached (and surpassed) their goal, and made application!
