#### A Few Updates

I arrived back from Newfoundland on Tuesday night, just hours before the sleet storm started. Needless to say, Wednesday was not a very good day to be out and about. I spent a month with my mother, being her 'chief cook and bottle washer'. She is continuing to struggle with her health. As I was leaving, we took her to my niece's home for a month, then she will spend another month or so with other family, until winter ends. Please keep my mother Mary in prayer.

While I was away, the Gas Company tagged our boilers in the parish hall for 45 days. We've had many problems with those boilers. Apparently, the company who installed them in 2009, and who have been maintaining them ever since, did not install the proper exhaust (not enough psi's)! It took another company (in early January )to diagnose the problem. Currently, we are fighting with the company to have them repair it. They claim it should be "grandfathered", as new regulations came into place after the installation date. This is way out of my league. We have a couple of weeks left to get it done. Needless to say, I uttered a few choice words across the Bay, while I was home! We'll keep you posted.

Today's readings tell us that we are all part of the plan that God has for the world. We have a role to play in the transformation of the world into the **Kingdom of God**. If we are truly Christian, then we must believe firmly in the mission of Jesus Christ, and be active in that mission!

In the first reading, Isaiah responded to the Lord's question, "Whom shall I send?" with *Here am I, send me*. Paul told the people of Corinth that God chose him to preach the Gospel even though he had been a persecutor of Christians. In the Gospel, Jesus called Peter, James and John, three fishermen, to be part of the plan to fish for people... to bring more people into God's Kingdom. They left all and followed Jesus!

God still has a burning desire to unite the world to Himself. Through our Baptism, we are called to bring new life, new hope, to the world. To be our best selves, engage his mission, proclaim the Gospel. We only have one life, so the question is, can we make this life, the best life possible, a life modeled on His? ## World Day of the Sick and Our Lady of Lourdes

Monday, February 11th is World Day of the Sick. Pope John Paul II initiated the day in 1992 to encourage people to pray for those who suffer from illness and for their caregivers. The Holy Father himself had been diagnosed with Parkinson's a year before, and it is considered that his own illness was impetus for his designation of the day. *World Day of the Sick* was first observed on February 11, 1993. This is also the *Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes*, which is another title given to the Blessed Virgin Mary in honor of the apparitions that took place in and around Lourdes, France, by a young girl called Bernadette Soubirous in 1858.
