# PASTOR

We received word on Monday that our former pastor, Fr. Bruce Taggart, O.Carm., passed away peacefully in hospice care in Darien, IL. He was 83. At the time of this bulletin publication, we did not have any details of final arrangements. We are expecting that a Funeral Mass will be celebrated in Darien, IL, with an internment at a later date in the Carmelite section of Our Lady of Peace Cemetery.

Fr. Bruce professed his First Vows in the Order of Carmelites on June 15, 1992, and his Solemn Vows on October 28, 1995. He was ordained to the Priesthood on May 24, 1997. He taught Philosophy for several years at the Washington Theological Union before coming to St. Pat's in 2004. He was our pastor for three years before retiring to Mount Carmel Spiritual Centre in Niagara Falls, and later to Mount Carmel Retirement Residence in Darien, IL.. May Fr. Bruce rest in peace.

As I prepare this bulletin, it is heartbreaking to see the devastation in Turkey and Syria and other areas, from the major earthquake that hit the region on Monday morning. The magnitude 7.8 quake brought down entire apartment blocks in Turkish cities and piled more devastation on millions of Syrians displaced by years of war. It struck before sunrise in harsh weather, giving people little time to escape. This was followed in the early afternoon by another large quake. To date some 5000 people have been killed, and thousands injured. Pope Francis expressed his deep sadness when he learned of the huge loss of life. He offered his heartfelt condolences to those mourning losses. We keep the people of Turkey, Syria, and other impacted countries deep in our prayer. May the Spirit of Healing blow over their land.

# Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Our Gospel this Sunday continues Jesus' Sermon on the Mount. Just as Moses went up Mount Sinai to bring the Ten Commandments, [God's Law] to the people, Jesus climbs the Mount of the Beatitudes to present the New Law to the people. He opens with, "Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have come not to abolish but to *fulfill.*" He insists that the holiness of the people must surpass that of the scribes and the Pharisees. We know what the Pharisees were all about! Very external, holier than thou! It is not enough for others to see us performing the actions of Christians, our whole attitude in life must be Christian, must be love. Jesus looks at each Commandment... You heard that it was said... and he takes each one a step further! For example, murder. Jesus says it is wrong even to have anger and hatred in your heart. For murder comes from these internal motivations. Seek reconciliation and peace. These are Christ-like gualities. We must look at each Law and find meaning, look at the internal causes of our external actions. If we keep Christ in our hearts and souls, then we need never fear breaking his commandments of love. His Law is supposed to be life-giving and freeing! May we find the strength and grace to follow his Law of Love, and rid ourselves of any interior motivations to sin!


