

Dear Friends:

Lent has officially begun! On Wednesday, hundreds came out to Mass to have ashes marked on their foreheads. These ashes, from last year's burned Palm Branches, are a reminder that we are creatures, under God's care. We are human, made in the image and likeness of God. And God who created us, calls us into relationship... and calls us back when we wander. Ashes are also a reminder of our mortality, "Remember you are dust and unto dust you shall return!"




Today's Gospel scene occurs after Jesus'
Baptism. The Spirit drove him out into the desert
for 40 days, with wild beasts... and he was
tempted by Satan, and angels waited on him.
The 1st Sunday of Lent always deals with
TEMPTATION!!! Unfortunately, temptations are

everywhere and they can be tough to fight. The day we think we're no longer subject to temptation, is the day we should take our pulse, because we're probably dead. All sin is attractive! If it wasn't, we wouldn't be tempted by it.

In the desert, Jesus was tempted by Satan to save his own life and to reject his Father's plan. But his love for his Father and his love for us were more powerful than anything Satan or the world could tempt him with. When we **choose Christ**, the devil doesn't stand a chance. Jesus fights with us, never gives up on us, especially when evil or sin makes inroads into our lives.

These 40 days of Lent can be spent looking for ways to grow in our love for God and for each other. Can we work harder at fighting off temptation? Can we give God our sins in the **Sacrament of Reconciliation?** Can we unite ourselves to Him through more active participation in the Eucharist and all forms of prayer? Can we get out of our own wills and allow God's grace to come deeper into our lives? Can we increase our help for the poor? We pray for courage and strength to live **Christ-filled lives!** With Christ at the helm, and at the center of our lives, nothing that the world throws at us will defeat us. He is the conqueror of temptation, the victor over sin. Have a grace-filled Lent!

The other 10% is used for school fees for the most desperate, a school uniform to replace the most tattered, also notebooks and pencils, and in dire cases, to purchase a goat for very needy families.
